CPA Meritorious Student Abstracts:

Preliminary Normative Data of the Poreh and Martincin Naming Tests

Martincin K, Miller A, Poreh AM.

Objective: The goal of the study was to improve upon previously published visual naming tests by measuring latency of response and updating items, and to develop an auditory naming test that also measures latency. This was done by developing new computer software to conduct such tests. **Method:** Randomly sampled adults were given a test of verbal fluency, the Boston Naming Test, the Poreh Naming Test for visual naming abilities, and the Martincin Naming Test for auditory naming abilities. Each of the new tests use a computer program to measure accuracy and latency. **Results:** Data collection is ongoing; however preliminary data suggests performance on the the Poreh Naming Test, a visual naming test, has been found to be significantly correlated with the Boston Naming Test ($r = -.599, p < .01$). Performance on the Martincin Naming Test, an auditory naming test, was not found to be significantly correlated with either the Boston Naming Test or the Poreh Naming Test; this was expected as auditory naming sites in the Temporal Lobe have been found to be separate from visual naming sites in other research.
